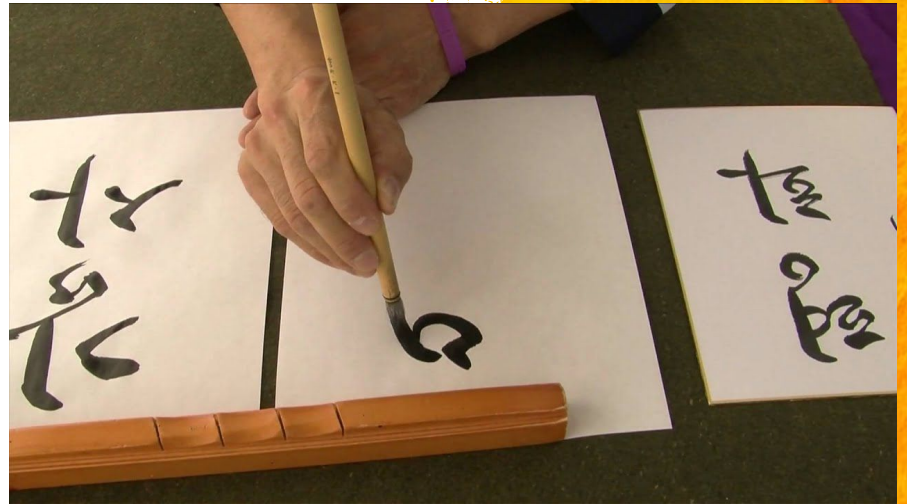

History of Korean Calligraphy

- × Introduced to Korea by the Chinese
- × Involves Chinese characters (Hanja) and Korean (Hangeul)
- × Used to convey the artists' emotions while showcasing important parts of Korean culture



Korean Calligraphy:

1. Special paper will be given
2. Outline your Korean name on paper with pencil
3. Korean letters papers will be handed out or at the station you're writing at
4. One of the teachers will help you outline your name with **black ink** (STUDENT IS **NOT ALLOWED** TO WRITE ON THEIR OWN)



History of Chinese Fans:

- × First used as shade covers in horse drawn carriages
- × Birds and flowers painted to symbolize beauty and gracefulness
- × Some had calligraphy of ancient stories that depicted wisdom and knowledge
- × Mythical creatures were also popular choices



How to make Chinese Fan:

1. Write Customized calligraphy or drawing on paper plate
2. Decorate plate with cherry blossoms and other personal designs (name)
3. Hot glue gun popsicle sticks and plate together
4. Add more details (personal choice)
